FUNDRAISING TALK

I am presenting an illustrated talk entitled ‘Pals, Terriers & Tommies’ at Brindle Community Hall, near Chorley on **Friday, 22nd July**, starting at 8.00 p.m. The talk tells the story of just a few of the many men from the town who fought in the First World War. It is in aid of the **CHORLEY REMEMBERS** project, whose aim is to place the names of the fallen from Chorley around the town’s Cenotaph.
